Summer Student Parks Maintenance (Casual)

The City of Charlottetown is seeking mature students to work with our Parks and Recreation Department, hours of work and length of work term may vary. To qualify for this position applicant must be able to provide acceptable proof returning to school/college/university or provide proof of completion of final year of school providing they have been employed in the previous summer(s).

The following duties which casuals may work include:

- Grass maintenance which may include operating small ride-on mowers and using whipper snippers.
- Operation of mobile watering vehicles.
- Carpentry.
- Garbage removal.
- Installing and removal of signage and posts.
- Field line layout and initial lining.
- Field maintenance.
- Trail surface maintenance.
- Installing playground equipment.
- Non-technical pool maintenance.
- Painting dugouts, sheds, equipment, etc., on park property.
- Sodding in park areas.
- Other duties as required.

Qualifications:

- Knowledge or experience in landscaping, turf, or horticultural would be considered an asset.
- Ability to operate vehicles including half-ton trucks.
- Ability to operate grass cutting equipment including mowers and whipper snippers.
- Must have the ability to work independently.
- WHMIS and First Aid training would be considered an asset.
- Must have reliable transportation.
- Must have excellent communication skills, both written and oral.
- Must have a valid driver's license.
- Must be available to work varied shifts, including evenings and weekends.

- Must be physically able to complete all tasks required which may include bending, crouching, heavy lifting (50 lbs), extensive rotating neck and shoulders, climbing ladders, pushing, pulling, walking, and standing, sitting, and/or raising arms for extended periods of time.
- Must adhere to all City policies including maintaining a satisfactory Criminal Reference Check.
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada.
