City of Charlottetown, PEI A Bylaw to Amend the City of Charlottetown Election Bylaw Bylaw # 2018-08-B

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:

PART I - INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION

1. Title

1.1. This bylaw shall be known and cited as the "Election Amendment Bylaw."

2. Purpose

The purpose of this bylaw is to amend the City of Charlottetown's Election Bylaw (#2018-08) to reflect recent revisions to the Municipal Election Regulations whereby candidates cannot be election officials, and a 'closely connected person' cannot be an election official.

3. Authority

3.1. Pursuant to Part 5, Section 134 (1) – Revision of Bylaws of the Municipal Government Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-12.

4. Definitions

4.1. In this bylaw, any word and term that is defined in the Municipal Government Act, Municipal Election Regulations, and the Campaign Contributions and Election Expenses Bylaw Regulations. and the City of Charlottetown Election Bylaw has the same meaning as in that Act or bylaw.

5. Part IV – Nomination of Candidates - of the City of Charlottetown Election Bylaw is hereby amended by the following:

5.1. Add new subsection 10.4 titled "Candidates":

"Pursuant to subsection 12(2.1) of the Election Regulations, a candidate in an election is not eligible to be appointed, and shall not serve, as an election official in the election."

5.2. Add new subsection 10.5 titled "Person Closely Connected":

"Pursuant to subsection 18(3) of the Election regulations, a person closely connected, as defined in the Act, to a candidate shall not serve as an election official in the election.
